WHEREAS, Chefs Appreciation Day helps provide chefs and their families a taste of life that shows compassion, respect and acknowledgment for their gifts; and


WHEREAS, The City of Buffalo supports the fight against cancer, honoring the survivors and remembering those who will forever live in our hearts.
