WHEREAS, in the City of Burlington "It's all about supporting the fight against cancer, honoring the survivors and remembering those who will forever live in our hearts."


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of the City of Burlington, Iowa do hereby proclaim Saturday, August 16, 2014 as

"Chefs Appreciation Day"


